

KERDI TIP SHEET

GENERAL

- Shower bases, curbs, and ramps can be cut to fit with a utility knife. Bases can be extended using dry-pack mortar.
- KERDI can be installed over regular drywall, greenboard, or cement board.

INSTALLATION TIPS

- Cut and mark all waterproofing components prior to mixing thin-set mortar.
- Wipe down the floor and wall with a damp sponge to remove any dust. Wet particularily dry and porous surfaces like cement board.
- Use 1/4" x 3/8" square or U-notched trowel to install all foam products and 1/4" x 3/16" V-notched trowel to install all KERDI membrane and KERDI-BAND products.
- The mortar to install the KERDI waterproofing membrane and accessories must be fairly fluid in consistency, but still able to hold a notch.
- Use premium unmodified thin-set mortars to install all shower components and porcelain, ceramic, and natural stone products.
- "Key In" mortar Apply a thin layer of mortar with the flat side of the trowel before combing additional mortar with the notched side.
- Mortar should be combed in one direction to help prevent air pockets.
- Embed KERDI into mortar using the flat side of the trowel or drywall
 finishing knife and work out air bubbles from the center to the edges.
 Use light to moderate pressure and don't try to evacuate all the
 mortar from behind the KERDI material.
- All seams must be overlapped by a minimum of 2" with KERDI or KERDI-BAND.
- Be sure to check for proper thin-set mortar coverage between KERDI and the substrate (full contact and no mortar ridges or air pockets remaining).
