








How many items on this **Lowe's**  **list** can you complete?

## In the Garden

- ☐ **Use a sprinkler to water the grass** (and run through it a few times too). 
- ☐ **Set a timer and see how many weeds you can pull in 5 minutes.**
- ☐ **Take a trip to Lowe's Garden Center** and pick up some supplies, veggies, and flowers. 
- ☐ **Look for helpful bugs, like ladybugs, in the garden.** 
- ☐ **Help your kids plant an easy-to-grow direct sow seed** like cucumber or zucchini.
- ☐ **Make garden markers using round flat stones.** Paint the fruit, flower or veggie on it to place near a row of seeds or seedlings.

- ☐ **Build a bird house,** then keep track of how many you see.

## Outdoor Cleanup

☐ **Get ready for a beach day by cleaning out those sand toys from last year,** use buckets with soapy water and clean water to rinse.

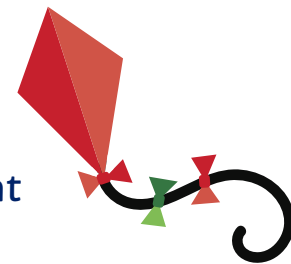
☐ **Help wash the car** – the more bubbles, the better!
